The complete student health history and physical examination report forms may be submitted no later than two weeks prior to your program start date. You must upload the completed SHTM Health Form with relevant lab reports (that have quantitative results) to the following:

2. CASTLEBRANCH (*instructions to follow in a separate email*)

Note: All students rotating through Stony Brook Medicine facilities will be required to also complete a Criminal Background Check via CastleBranch. Medical clearance for Respirator Fit Testing may also be required.

Please remember that all completed health forms with attached laboratory quantitative results must be received no later than two weeks prior to your program start date.

Conditions of Admission: Documentation of outstanding conditions of admission must also be received prior to the start of classes.

It is up to you to provide documentation, as instructed, to waive the Student Health Insurance if you have other coverage.
