

Professional Licensure Disclosure Respiratory Therapy

Stony Brook University Respiratory Care Program is accredited by Middle States Commission on Higher Education Accreditation and by the Commission on Accreditation for Respiratory Care (COARC).

This program is designed to meet the educational requirements for respiratory therapists in New York State. If you intend to seek licensure outside of New York State after finishing your program, use the link below to find information on the state or U.S. territory in which you intend to be licensed in order to identify whether Stony Brook University Respiratory Therapy program meets, does not meet, or if it has not been determined if it meets the educational requirements for licensure. If Stony Brook University Respiratory Therapy program has not determined if it meets the educational requirements for licensure in the state in question, it may meet all or a portion of the educational requirements.
